

## Communication with Medical Practitioners and the Public

- 8.1 To enhance communication between the Medical Council and members of the profession as well as the public, a series of forums were organized in the year. These forums aimed at keeping them informed of the role and functions of the Medical Council and its statutory committees. In particular, their views and comments on the reform proposals of the Medical Council were sought.
