

2 Membership of the Medical Council and the General Election held in 2004

2.1 The Council comprises 24 medical practitioners and 4 lay members. The Director of Health is the ex-officio Registrar. Its composition is as follows:-

(a) 2 registered medical practitioners nominated respectively by:-

- the Director of Health;
- the University of Hong Kong;
- the Chinese University of Hong Kong;
- the Hospital Authority;
- the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine;

(b) 7 registered medical practitioners nominated and elected by the Hong Kong Medical Association;

(c) 7 registered medical practitioners who are ordinarily resident in Hong Kong elected by all registered medical practitioners; and

(d) 4 lay members.

The Council's Legal Adviser is Mr Charles C.C. CHAN and its Secretary is Mr H Y AU who replaced Mr Raymond CHIU with effect from 1 June 2004.

2.3 Dr YEUNG Chiu-fat, Henry was re-elected and Professor WEI William Ignace was elected to replace Dr CHOW Pak-chin with effect from 24 January 2004. Dr CHOW Pak-chin was elected by the Hong Kong Medical Association to replace Dr LAI Cham-fai with effect from 24 January 2004. On the nomination of the Chinese University of Hong Kong, Professor LAU Wan-yee, Joseph was appointed to replace Professor CHUNG Sheung-chee, Sydney from 25 August 2004 to 23 January 2006. On the nomination of the Hospital Authority, Dr LIU Shao-haei was appointed to replace Dr KO Wing-man from 16 November 2004 to 23 January 2006.

2.4 The 9th election of the Council was conducted in September 2004 to fill two vacancies for a period of 3 years with effect from 24 January 2005. Since the number of validly nominated candidates was the same as the number of vacancies (i.e. two vacancies), the following candidates were declared to be elected:-
